The Gospel-Centered Family - Ephesians 6:1-4

1. For the Children - Ephesians 6:1-2 (Exodus 20:12)
2. For the Parents - Ephesians 6:4 (Deut. 6:4-9, Eph. 5:22-28)
3. For the Church - Ephesians 6:1 (Heb. 10:24,25)

- How do you discipline children in a way that teaches the Gospel?
- How do you "diligently teach" your children God's commandments at all times (Deut. 6:6-9)
- If you are a parent, have you modeled to your children by your marriage how to honor and obey?
- How do you better model "honoring and obeying" those in authority over you?
- Do you need to ask your parents or children for forgiveness for either how you obey and honor or how you lead your household?
