Life Group Questions: 4 Biblical Ways to Honor our Mothers

Ephesians 6:2

- 1. In Exodus 20:12 and Ephesians 6:2 we are commanded to "honor" our fathers and mothers.
 - What is the core sense of both the Old Testament and New Testament words for honor? [the notion of value]
 - What are two different ways that this core notion is used in Scripture? [to esteem highly and offering money]
 - How does the English word honorarium show one of these ideas?
 - Some people had horrible parents. Is it still possible to honor them? If so, how?
 - Have you ever had to honor your mom or dad, even when you disagreed with them?



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Ephesians 6:1

- 2. How are Children to honor their parents? (Ephesians 6:1). [Children are to obey their mothers and fathers].
 - Is this an absolute statement? (in other words, is their ever an exception?) If not, what are the exceptions?
 - Some children have horrible mothers and fathers. Are they still obligated to obey? If not, what are the exceptions?

Read Genesis 2:18-24

- 3. In Genesis 2:18-19, God recreates pairs of male and female animals in front of Adam and has him name them.
 - Why does he do this? See especially 2:18 & 2:20? [God was showing Adam his need of a partner that is suitable and corresponding to him.]



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- 4. In Genesis 2:24 God establishes the institution of marriage. How is it described? [Leaving and Cleaving].
 - What does this mean for the new family that was created through marriage? [It is a breaking away and forming a new, independent unit—no necessary obedience.]
 - Are married children still expected to honor their parents? [Yes, but not by obeying. In other ways].
 - What are some ways you can honor you mother (and father) after leaving and cleaving?
 - The relationship of between new couples and their parents can be challenging. As either a new parent couple or a new married couple, have you had to deal with this tension? If so, how have you handled it in a biblical way?
- 5. How is the biblical institution of marriage under attack today?
 - What are some ways that you feel our culture denigrates marriage and/or motherhood?
 - How do we fight against this influence in the family? In our Church? In our culture?



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Read Proverbs 23:22-25

- 6. What are we to avoid with our older mothers? [Despising them]
 - What does the term despise mean? What does it mean in this context? [ignoring their godly advice]
 - How does this passage tell us to give our mothers (and fathers) joy? [by living wise and righteous lives.]

Read 1 Timothy 5:8

- 7. How are we to honor our mothers in this verse? [taking care of our aging parents]
 - How are you doing this? Do you need to do more?
