**Scriptures:** Psalm 96

- 1. Share a time or season in your life as a believer when your personal worship seemed distant, detached or even nonexistent. Why was worship difficult?
- 2. Describe a time/season in your life when your worship was fresh and vibrant. What factors contributed to this?
- 3. What does it mean to sing a "new song"? (v. 1)
- 4. How do you "bless His name"? (v. 2)
- 5. Take time to recount some of God's "marvelous works" in the Bible. Why are those accounts meaningful to you? What do they teach you about God's character or nature?
- 6. What does it mean to "fear God"? How can we approach God if he strikes fear in people?
- 7. Take time to share your personal testimonies focusing on when you understood and received His offer of salvation? Does that still cause you to sing a new song to the Lord?
- 8. Read vs 11-13. What aspects of creation are called to exult the Lord? How does creation sing/ declare God's glory? (read Romans 8:20-23; Luke 19:40; Psalm 148).
- 9. Describe some practical ways for individuals or families to prepare for corporate worship.
- 10. How do you incorporate daily worship into your life?
- 11. On 2 occasions Psalm 96 mentions that God will judge the people (vs 10, 13). Who will be judged? How will He judge?
- 12. Are you confident that you are ready for that judgment?
- 13. How does the call to declare God's glory to the nations and the knowledge of Him coming to judge the nations drive our witness to the world?
- 14. Do you know how to prepare and share your testimony? (share with your group)
- 15. Can you give a clear presentation of the Gospel?
